Who may participate? Any Cub Scout with a clear understanding of the rules of chess. *Participating scouts must know the basic rules of chess: How the pieces move, the object of the game, and castling rules, and should be mature enough to handle victory and defeat. No instruction on the basic rules of chess will be given as part of the tournament.*

What are the details? The cost is \$12.00 per scout. A brief description of the tournament rules will be explained before the start of the tournament. These include *touch move* – if a piece is touched it must be moved.

What to bring? Scouts should wear uniforms; bring a bag lunch, chess board & pieces.
